## **Rationing and World War One historylearning**

Rationing wasn't actually introduce to Britain until right at the end of World War One in February 1918. Rationing was a response to a U boat campaign carried out by the Germans, which resulted in a loss of supplies;

the Defence of the Realm Act (DORA) was enforced to ensure that food shortages did not occur, so rationing kept the public from facing starvation.
