Agriculture is Germany's biggest land user. More than half of the German land surface is farmed (over 18 million hectares; 51.7 percent). The second largest land user is forestry, which takes up nearly a third of the land area. 13.7 percent of the land surface is occupied by human settlements and transportation.
