Simplifying fractions. In this 5th grade lesson, I explain how to simplify a fraction using a visual model and an arrow notation. Simplifying fractions is like joining or merging pieces together, and it is the opposite of finding equivalent fractions and splitting the pieces further. We combine prime factorization with reducing fractions. Just cross out all the common prime factors as "one" and what your left with is the reduce fraction.

Simplifying Fractions Math is Fun

To simplify a fraction, divide the top and bottom by the highest number that can divide into both numbers exactly. Simplifying (or reducing) fractions means to make the fraction as simple as possible.

Teaching Reducing Fractions to Elementary School Students. Begin with a fraction that can be reduced like $\frac{8}{16}$ and ask students to again find as many fair trades with the Fraction Circles as they can for the fraction and to record them from "greatest terms " (biggest numbers) to "lowest terms " (smallest terms).
